COUNTY PARK NURSERY

We are a small specialist nursery in Essex with a large range of several thousand species and varieties of plants.

County Park Nursery was begun in 1955 by Graham and Margaret Hutchins. At first it was a general nursery, but gradually we specialised in New Zealand, Australian and Tasmanian plants, retaining some of the more unusual plants from other areas of the world.

About half of the nursery contains specimen, show and stock plants. Many of our plants are grown from seed which was collected in the wild during four plant expeditions in New Zealand and Australia in 1977, 1981, 1985 and 1990.

We continue to raise new cultivars in several of the New Zealand, Tasmanian and Australian genera. Over 300 new plants have been raised and named at County Park Nursery. Several have received the R.H.S Award of Merit.

LOCATION

The nursery is situated on the north edge of Hornchurch in Essex, about 25 miles from the centre of London in an eastward direction. The nursery entrance is in Essex Gardens, off Wingletye Lane. The postcode is **RM11 3BU**

Directions by car

From the M25 exit at junction 29, and take the A127 westward towards London for about 2.5 miles.

After passing the BP garage and The Palms Hotel (both on right) take the next turning left into Wingletye Lane.

Soon you will see a petrol station, turn left here into Essex Gardens and park along this road.

The Nursery entrance is between the petrol station and the small parade of shops.

Directions by public transport

The nursery is about 1.25 miles from Harold Wood Station (main line from Liverpool St.) Take a taxi from the station.

Alternatively, we are about 1.25 miles from Upminster Bridge Station. (Underground District line), from where taxis are also available.

If you go to Hornchurch Station, (the stop before Upminster Bridge), cross the road, and take the 193 bus which terminates almost at the Nursery entrance. The bus service is every 12 minutes Monday - Saturday and every 30 minutes on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

PLEASE NOTE:

Prices quoted above are intended as a guide only and are subject to change. When quoting a price for a specific specimen, the plant's size as well as the pot size is taken into account.

Several plants in this list will not be available until late spring or early summer.

There may be occasions when some plants listed are not available. As we grow a large variety of plants in very small quantities, inevitably some of our plants are soon sold out.

We grow many other plants which are not listed here, including Podocarpus from Africa and America, Pittosporums from Asia and other unusual plants from around the world.

We are no longer printing a paper version of our plant list and are drastically reducing our range. However, we are still raising several new plants.

HARDINESS

(See 2nd column (H) of plant list)

CODE ▼	INDICATION OF HARDINESS
1	Tender plants which require a situation with very little or no frost.
2	Plants that will tolerate temperatures of -1°C to -3°C
3	Plants that require a warm garden or unheated greenhouse. Minimum -3°C to -5°C
4	Reasonably hardy plants which will tolerate -5°C to -12°C . Provide shelter in cold areas.
5	Plants which are hardy and can tolerate temperatures down to at least -15°C

NB. The hardiness codes in this list are intended as a guide only, as it is not possible to be 100% accurate. Bear in mind that softly grown and young plants are more vulnerable to frosts than established specimens, and two days at -8°C will do less damage than two weeks at -4°C .
